

ProjectPAK to ShopPAK Installation Instructions

1. Updating the Database Schema

Before you can use ShopPAK, you must update your ProjectPAK database to support ShopPAK. This can be performed on any PC that you've installed ProjectPAK upon. **You only have to apply the SQL schema updates once to your shared database.**

Note: Make sure that the Sybase SQL Anywhere database server is currently running before you proceed.

1. Click the Download button. Once downloaded, open the ShopPAK Database Update Scripts.zip file. Inside, you'll find 4 .sql files. Copy/Paste the files onto your Desktop or another familiar location.
2. Select **Start | Programs | ProjectPAK | SQL Utility**. This brings up the "Interactive SQL" Utility.
3. Select **File | Open** from the menu. This displays the "Open Command File" dialog box. Navigate to the location you chose to paste the sql files to. Select "**ShopPAK Update 1.sql**" and click the Open button.
4. In the Command window, click the Execute button. This runs the SQL command script. You'll know it is done when you don't see activity in the "Statistics" and "Command" windows, and the "Execute" button becomes enabled again. This database update only updates ShopPAK oriented tables.

Repeat the process for database script "**ShopPAK Update 2.sql**", "**ShopPAK Update 3.sql**" and "**ShopPAK Update 4.sql**". Once all 4 scripts have been ran, close the utility.

2. Install ShopPAK Client Software
